She quickly found that my skills were very advanced, so she hired me full-time. 3. Emily and I were great friends before the accident, but since then, I have moved to Paris shortly afterward to accept a job offer I couldn't refuse. I had gotten the offer before the accident but hadn't told Emily yet as I wasn't sure we would have the chance to talk much. 4. I was with Emily the night of the accident. We were having a couple of drinks at The Spice Route and arrived at around 9:00 p.m. Emily had heard rumors that the owner was interested in selling and that he had a backdoor business of selling recreational drugs. Emily had a substance problem with Adderall that I had helped support her through for many years. 5. David Sullivan, the owner, stopped by our table to say hello. David and I knew each other because we had long been
